**From the Pastor...**

Fr. Smith's birthday and farewell reception is scheduled for Sunday, Sept. 4<sup>th</sup> after the noon Mass. Father will be moving to Parker Place, which is a retirement community in Mentor. Thank you for the support you have offered him over the years. Please pray that another retired priest might be sent our way.

You may have heard about pending changes in the Mass. The Holy See authorized a new translation from the Latin texts. The translation is better and more elegant than what is presently in use. Beginning on September 14<sup>th</sup>, we are permitted to use the new musical settings for the various acclamations, such as the Holy, Holy and the Gloria. The full use of the new translation will be effective beginning on the first Sunday of Advent.

On September 11<sup>th</sup> the parish will begin Year II of RCIA. These classes are also for people who have never been confirmed, who are otherwise already Catholic. If you are an adult and have never been confirmed, please consider coming to these classes. Confirmation fully initiates a person into the Church and reinforces the graces given in Baptism. An unconfirmed Catholic is an "unfinished" Catholic. Besides, we need the Holy Spirit's influence more and more to grow in our faith, to defend it and to spread it.

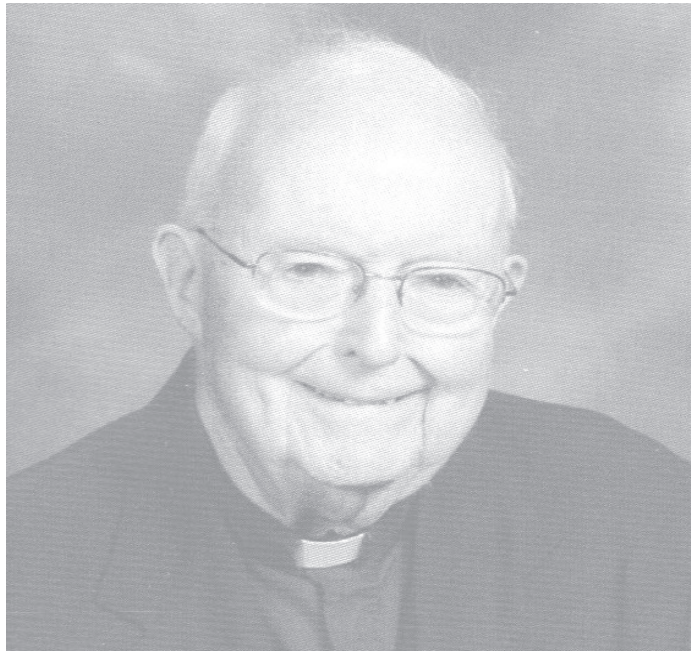

## PSR NEWS

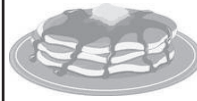
