### From the Pastor...

Catholic newspapers and Internet sites are reporting that five Anglican bishops have requested entry into the Catholic Church. The Holy Father has made provisions for these men to be re-ordained as Catholic priests. In order to serve the needs of many Anglican faithful who would also like to become Catholics, the Pope has erected a diocesan-like structure called an ordinariate. There will be ordinariates in various English-speaking countries, such as the U.S.

What is the attraction that the Church of Rome holds for many Anglicans? For one thing, there is a magisterium or teaching body, consistent of bishops in union with the Pope. In the Catholic Church, doctrine is defined. There are seven valid sacraments in the Catholic Church. (Protestant churches generally have two valid sacraments because they do not have the sacrament of Holy Orders.) Many Anglicans are disaffected by the ordination of women. They rightly understand this practice as being in conflict with apostolic teaching and divine revelation. Certainly the same-sex "marriage" issue has many Anglicans in an uproar (understandably so). They know that the Catholic Church will never allow such a thing because it is a crass violation of what God has provided when He created us male and female.

Let us pray for all new members of the Catholic Church, from wherever they come. Always be willing to speak about the faith to others, inviting them to become part of the Church that Jesus founded on the rock of Peter.
