From the Pastor...

I would like to address two subjects for consideration:
 Please be advised that only duly deputed ministers of the Eucharist (e.g., priests and deacons) and "extraordinary" ministers of Holy Communion (lay people officially trained and commissioned) can take the Eucharist to the sick and infirm who are homebound or confined to various health care facilities. The proper container for the consecrated host is a pyx. A pyx is a small metal case that is designed to hold hosts. The person using a pyx should, in turn, carry it in a burse, which is a pouch with a strap or cord that goes around the person's neck. It is a serious abuse to carry the Eucharist in a handkerchief, an envelope, or in anything that is not designed for this purpose. If you are designated to take Communion to the sick and do not have a pyx or a burse, please notify the parish office.
 The Church's Code of Canon Law (#827) indicates that books or other written materials dealing with religion or morals that do not have the proper ecclesiastical permission, are not to be displayed, given away or sold in churches. That being the case, the series of booklets published by "Christian Family Outreach" cannot be placed on any of our literature racks, tables, pews, etc., for public consumption. If anyone would like to make written materials available to the parish, please bring them to the parish office first. We will then make the determination as to their suitability.
