From the Pastor...

Pope John Paul is scheduled to be beatified this coming May. Beatification is one step away from full-fledged canonization. It would seem to be merely a matter of time before the former Holy Father is canonized, accordingly. In the meantime, I have dedicated my current Lenten series of teachings to Pope John Paul's plan for the millennium. This plan calls for a renewed commitment to holiness and prayer.

Christians, of all people, must learn to pray. Praying is an art. As Pope John Paul wrote, "The great mystical tradition of the Church.... shows how prayer can progress, as a genuine dialogue of love, to the point of rendering the person wholly possessed by the divine Beloved...." In other words, "[p]rayer develops that conversation with Christ that makes us his intimate friends." The late pontiff urges everyone to develop the art of prayer. There is no reason for anyone to be satisfied with a shallow prayer-life. Such a person would be (at best) a "mediocre Christian". The person would also run the risk of losing his faith, "preferring alternative religious proposals and even indulging in far-fetched superstitions".

I will be speaking about the art of prayer on Monday, March 28th at 7:30 p.m. in the Parish Center. All are welcome.

Re-Registration has begun for the 2011-2012 School Year



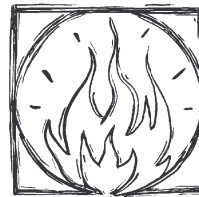

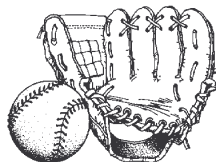
