**From the Pastor...**

A confidant of the late Pope John Paul indicated that he saw the pontiff angry only on two occasions. One was when the Holy Father preached in Sicily. He denounced organized crime. I saw the film footage. It seemed almost out of character for the spiritual leader to speak with such fury. The second time the pontiff indicated great upset was on the eve of the war with Iraq. Having come out of war-torn Poland, the Holy Father was no stranger to the horrors of war. Presently, the war lingers on, along with at least two others in which the U.S. is directly involved.

It is important to empathize with everyone affected by war (this includes not only those in the military, but also, many civilians, non-combatants, families, etc.) I say this as a priest and as one who served in the first Gulf War as a military chaplain. We need not be satisfied with the interminable conflicts that continue to plague our world. War should be a rare thing, waged only under very circumscribed conditions, and never be allowed to linger interminably (see the *Catechism of the Catholic Church*, nos. 2307-2317).

The world needs peace. Pray for peace. (The Blessed Mother is the Queen of Peace.) Finally, as St. Paul advises, pray for all in government, that the people in power make decisions that are just and supportive of peace.
